Rules and Directives.

The Pharr Police Training Division strives to provide professional and quality training for all personnel; therefore, it is imperative to maintain a professional learning environment that allows this learning process.

- All students must be in class on time.

Rules of attire:

- No pants that fall lower than the waistline.
- No Jeans.
- No spandex or warm ups.
- No sandals of any kind.
- No caps, hats.
